RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ALABAMA 9-1-1 BOARD

CHAPTER 585-X-1

LEGAL AUTHORITY

585-X-1-.02 Adoption Of Procedures, Rules And Regulations. The Alabama Statewide 911 Board is authorized to adopt procedures, rules and regulations as may be necessary to establish a statewide 9-1-1 charge, and to apply, collect the statewide 9-1-1 charge and distribute the funds from the 9-1-1 Fund and otherwise take action to efficiently and effectively ~~insure~~ensure the delivery of 9-1-1 services within the State of Alabama. The Statewide 911 Board is also authorized to adopt rules and regulations to fund advisory services, grants, and training for emergency communication districts within the State of Alabama.
