Update-Training Options

Hosted/contracted training

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Costs associated

• Tuition/materials, travel, lodging, meals, trainee's wage, replacement's wage (OT)

• Pros

- Interaction with classmates/classroom-setting
- Boost in trainees morale/worth
- High completion and passage rate

• Cons

- Expensive
- Limits the number of employees an agency can send
- Class-size limitations

• Examples

- PowerPhone's Suicide Intervention, Birmingham, December 2014
- PowerPhone's Active Shooter Response, Pelham, January 2015

Guided on-line training

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- Costs associated
- Tuition, trainee's wage

• Pros

- Guided or proctored for completion/appropriateness
- Variety of courses
- Does not take the trainee out of the center
- More name-brand or recognized
- CEUs/CDEs

• Cons

• Moderately expensive

• Examples

- PowerPhone's Emergency Medical Dispatch Qualification
- APCO's Public Safety Telecommunicator I

Self-paced training

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- Costs associated
- Tuition/membership, trainee's wage

• Pros

- Inexpensive
- Does not take the trainee out of the center

• Cons

- Limited courses
- Low completion rate

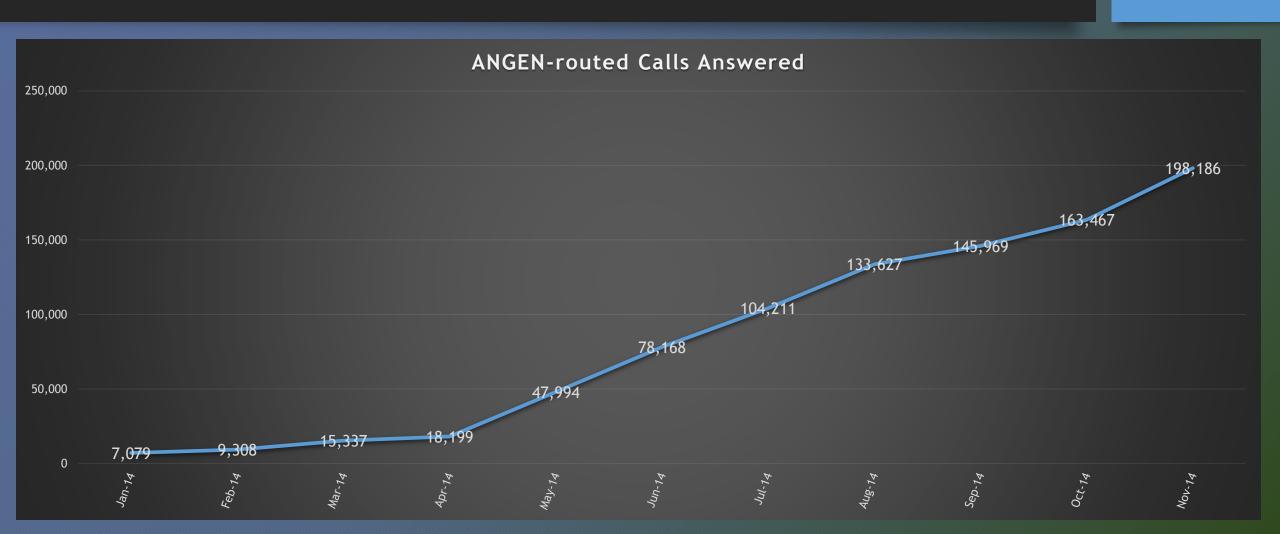

Update-Legislative & State Plan Work Session

Four potential key areas identified and discussed:

- Re-direct Cost Recovery to the creation of a 9-1-1 Trust Fund. The Trust Fund could help fund ANGEN; possibly provide additional funding for capital improvements, such as CPE equipment, for the local districts; etc.
