





Prior Grant Cycles Updates

- ❖ Grant Cycle 5 6 of 9 projects have been completed, with two of the outstanding projects being close to completion and one ECD that has been unresponsive in providing status updates.
- **❖** Grant Cycle 6 All of the Grant Cycle 6 projects are now complete.
- **❖** Grant Cycle 7 There is one project with an outstanding change request that is under review.
- ❖ Grant Cycle 8 14 of 33 projects have been completed. Two projects have change requests under review that have been reviewed and approved. Two ECDs have not submitted status reports and have been notified of such.











Grant Program Updates















ANGEN Improvements - MEVO Feature (Ndigital)

The new features include a barge, monitor and position transfer feature allowing MEVO the same functionality as PSAPs call handling equipment. Also added to the MEVO phone is a visual map display for 911 calls as well as a One Time Password for Texty authentication.

Texty Authentication Tokens will expire at the end of May so all sites remaining on Texty will need to be tested for the Texty OTP Authentication.

These site visits are invaluable as they serve as an opportunity to test call flow and educate dispatchers on the floor of various resources and upcoming events.














Intrado ALI Outage




Both Alabama Intrado links went down Wednesday, April 26th.

Multiple agencies experienced 911 calls from AT&T phones with no ALI.


INdigital was able to reroute the ALI links to search the Indiana and Florida ALI databases allowing ALI to be delivered to the PSAPs.

While Intrado reported the links were repaired two days later, the IN and FL links were kept active for redundancy.




INdigital is transitioning to a different authentication for Texty and our Toolkit Database.




The Locally Authoritative GIS Data Matters!

- ➤ Location Based Routing (LBR) is being rolled out nationwide
 - FCC rule FCC-24-4 released January 26, 2024
 - Will utilize our PSAP boundary layer
 - Delivered to T-Mobile and Comtech
- ➤ MSAG/ALI synchronization to GIS is a key metric for NG-9-1-1 Data readiness
 - MSAG/ALI VEP update state-wide into VEP
 - Will improve sync rates, but still work to be done
- > INdigital has provided GIS data requirements for ANGEN core functionality
 - Guidance given on road centerline and address points
 - In discussion with DATAMARK to provide GIS data remediation to meet these requirements

















North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) PL-626

❖On March 5, 2024, the Alabama Public Service Commission (Commission), in Docket No. 33429, approved an all-services distributed overlay over the 334 NPA. Cities in the 334 NPA include but are not limited to Montgomery, Dothan, Auburn, Prattville, Phenix City, Enterprise, Opelika, Selma and many other smaller communities. The new 483 NPA will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 334 NPA. Additionally, central office (CO) codes in the 334 NPA will be available for assignment only when all assignable prefixes in the 334 NPA have been assigned. The 334-334 NXX will be released as an assignable CO code after the new 483 NPA in-service date.






